After upgrade or uninstall SharePointBoost products, there might be some **invalid event receivers** left which will cause error messages in below screenshot.

At first, you need to find all of **SharePoint lists** which stores the invalid event receivers which caused the error messages you met with.

To find the SharePoint lists, for example, when the error message is the yellow line:

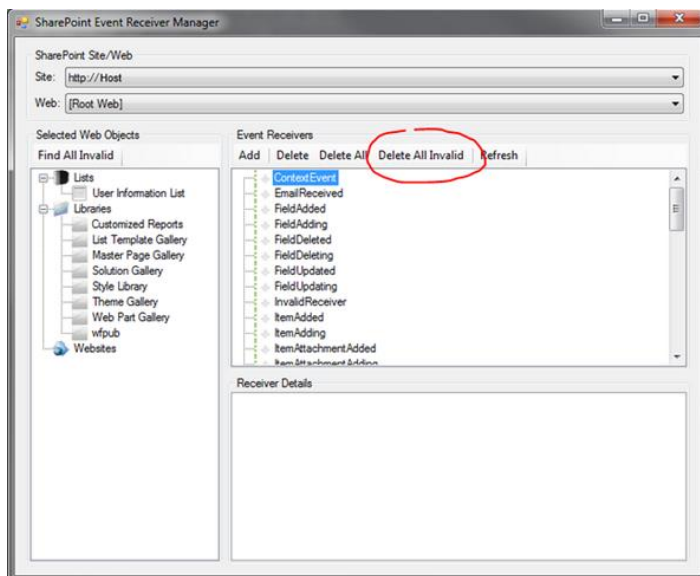
