System Requirements

Windows SharePoint Server 3.0 or Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007.

Microsoft SharePoint Foundation 2010 or Microsoft SharePoint Server 2010.

Microsoft SharePoint Foundation 2013 or Microsoft SharePoint Server 2013.

Required Components

Before install Column/View Permission Web service, please make sure Column/View Permission 3.0 or Permission Boost 3.0 is installed.

For **SharePoint 2007**, Column/View Permission Web Service need to be installed on the web front end which is installed and deployed SharePoint Web Application.

For **SharePoint 2010**, Column/View Permission Web Service need to be installed on the web front end which is installed and deployed Microsoft SharePoint Foundation Web Application.

For **SharePoint 2013**, Column/View Permission Web Service need to be installed on the web front end which is installed and deployed Microsoft SharePoint Foundation Web Application.

Install Column /View Permission Web Service

After extracting the installation file, find "ColumnViewPermissionWebServices.exe" file and run it.
